

Camper Dress Code and Personal Items Guidelines

Dress Code:

We request that you monitor the clothing that your child bring to camp and make sure that it is camp appropriate. Please keep the following in mind when helping your camper pack for Blue Mountain Ranch:

- No clothing with expletives printed
- No Extra low-riding pants
- No Chained wallets
- No “gang” clothing
- Please have your child remove any piercings other than ears
- We ask campers not wear pajamas outside cabins (without camp director consent)
- Please no bathing suits outside cabin’s or pool area (basically no parading around in your bathing suit)
- Please remember we are Blue MOUNTAIN Ranch and camp appropriate shoes are a must. Spike heels and flip-flops are a killer here.
- Clean underwear

Personal Items Guidelines:

While we want your camper to feel at home at camp and encourage them to bring comfort items such as stuffed animals, special pillows, cards, books and other camp appropriate personal items, please do not send the following items:

- Valuable or precious items
- Large, noisy “jam boxes”
- Music including expletives
- Gameboys or other electronic equipment
- Expensive jewelry
