Observable Behavioral Outcomes that Address Camper's Developmental Needs

In order to have a fulfilling camp experience, a camper must:

❖ Develop Friendship

- Staff must model appropriate behavior
- Do "Highs and Lows" or "Pass the Candle" periodically
- Create good cabin environment
 - ♦ Create cabin rules together
 - ♦ Work together as team during cabin activities (i.e. inspection, sing song, skit night)
- Reiterate camp motto, "A friend is worth a mountain made of gold, they cannot be bought or sold."
- Reiterate importance of friendship and share examples at worship

❖ Develop Independence/Responsibility

- Chores around the cabin
- Self cleanliness
- Campers choose own activities
- Limit phone calls home
- Staff instill in campers a sense of self confidence
 - ♦ Remain positive
 - Get campers involved in activities
 - Push campers to set goals and then achieve them

***** Feel a sense of Acceptance

- Camp must be safe environment
 - ♦ No bullying (verbal and physical)
 - Camp must be tolerant of all ideas
- Every activity, formal and non-formal, are all inclusive
- Do not tolerate negativity
- Be patient
 - ♦ Staff must put themselves in the other's shoes
 - ♦ Have a sense of humor
 - ♦ Take deep breaths

***** Have Fun

- Staff must have infectious enthusiasm
- Smile
- Laugh at yourself
- Keep everyone involved

❖ Develop and/or Expand Upon Good Moral Values

- Weekly worship
 - ♦ Staff will relate to camper's moral dilemmas and fortitude
- Staff must model appropriate behavior
- Camp values must be evident in camp rules
